

Directions to Tein Telecom Belgium

Coming from Mons & Paris

Take the E19 highway towards Brussels, until the junction with the R0 ringroad from Brussels. Take the R0 ringroad towards Brussels, until the first point of the description " Coming from Antwerp, Gent, Ostend and the Netherlands " (below).

Coming from Antwerp, Ghent, Ostend & The Netherlands

Take the R0 ringroad from Brussels towards Liège / Zaventem (note : when you come from the E19, do not go on the R0 ringroad, but exit in the extension of the E19). Take the exit A201 - Brussels / Zaventem, towards Brussels. Follow Avenue Leopold III for 5 km (you will pass the NATO headquarters on your left) until the end of this avenue. There, go left onto the Blvd General Wahis and then **keep right** so you will enter the Place Meiser. There, take the 2nd right, Av. Rogier, and follow this street for 1 km. You will pass 2 traffic lights before you arrive at a big square with trees: this is Place des Bienfaiteurs.

Coming from Liège

Take the E40 highway towards Brussels. When you arrive in Brussels, keep on the right and follow signs for Reyers/Meiser. Take the tunnel to Reyers/ Meiser. About 100m after the tunnel, you will arrive at traffic lights. Turn left, and take the second street on the right off of the roundabout; follow Avenue Rogier (a broad avenue with a tram line in the middle). After 1 km, you will arrive on a big square: this is Place des Bienfaiteurs.

Coming by public transports & train

From the Station Brussels-North (Nord/Noord). Take tram **no.25** towards Midi/ Zuid (6 trams per hour ; the ride takes about 10 minutes). Get off at "Place des Bienfaiteurs".
